The future is bright as we see lemon and lime shades enlivening interiors

Looking at the collections presented at this year's Milan Design Week, there was one colour story that surprised us. Normally we'd overlook an acidic yellow with a hint of green – almost a chartreuse – as something we could use at home. But, in Milan, it felt fresh – a truly modern take on yellow that we can see becoming a trend. At Dolce & Gabbana Casa, the bright, lemon-yellow designs – part of a collaboration with Italian ceramicist Antonio Aricò – represent the juice of the citrus fruit; the installation 'Butterfly Effect' at Danish design studio H+O's Milan apartment gallery, shown here, used paint brand Fie's Under Pop's Lime Juice. It's got us thinking of the trend for digital colours – saturated, bright and somewhat artificial: a more experimental approach to colour for the truly bold.
